**426. Public Question Time**

- **Public wanted to know why the option of reducing of the Parish was not given on the SBC letter**
- **The residents were not given the Choice to abolish**
- **SBC decided to abolish the Parish on the SBC meeting on the 18<sup>th</sup> December 2018. SBC ignored completely the will of the residents**
- **Many of the Residents stated that they did not receive any communication from the SBC regarding voting of abolishing of Wexham Court Parish Council**
- **Some of the residents had received a letter from Cathrine Meek of SBC democratic services department , stating that the Audit Review came to the conclusion that Parish Councillors were not fit to be Councillors**
- **Residents would like the Parish Council to challenge the decision of the SBC to abolish the Parish**
- **Many of the residents voiced that SBC were asset grabbing and green field will be used for housing- Cllr Sohal pointed out that at the SBC meeting of the 18<sup>th</sup> December 2018, assurances were given that open spaces and allotments will not be built on.**
- **There were shouts of go for Judicial Review- and challenge the SBC**
- **Residents also pointed out that apparently Cathrine Meek did have a public consultation meeting BUT information about the meeting was not sent to the residents**

- Cllr Sohal pointed out that a big Lorry is being parked at the Cherries near the Camera
